HOW TO SET TIME:

1. Pull out the crown for a click.
2. Turn the crown clockwise and set the date to one day before the date desired.(FOR SOME MODELS.TURN COUNTER-CLOCKWISE)

3. Pull out the crown for another click to the 3rd Position and turn it clockwise moving the hands until the date change to the desired date.

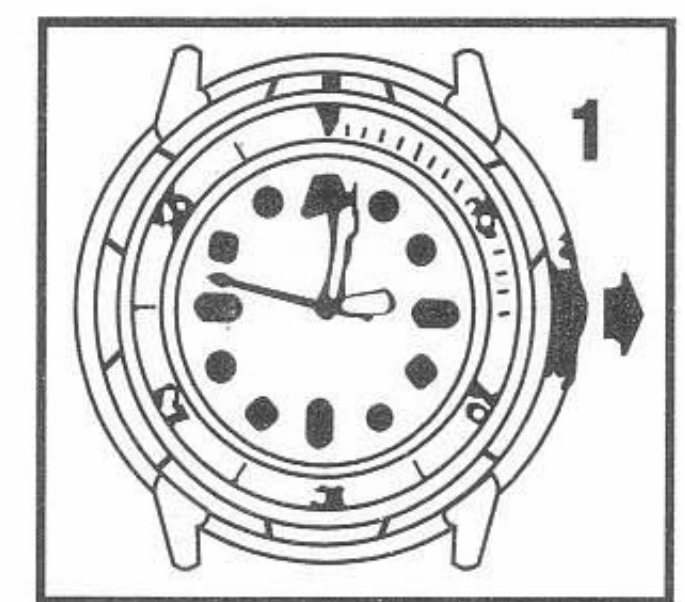
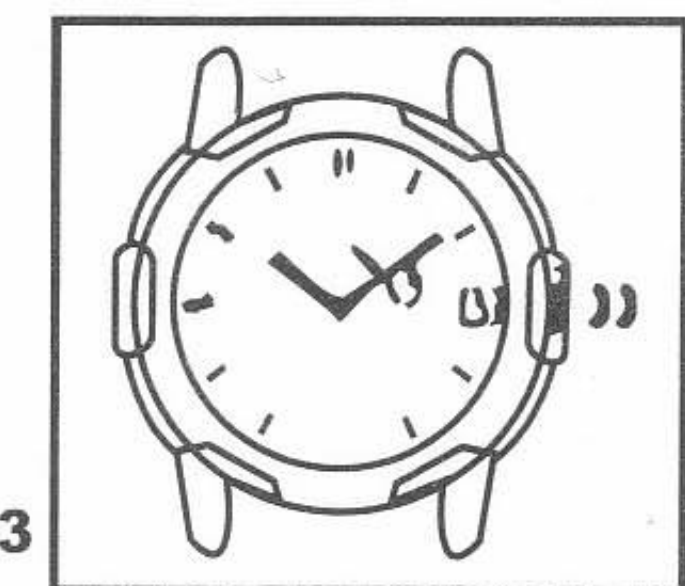
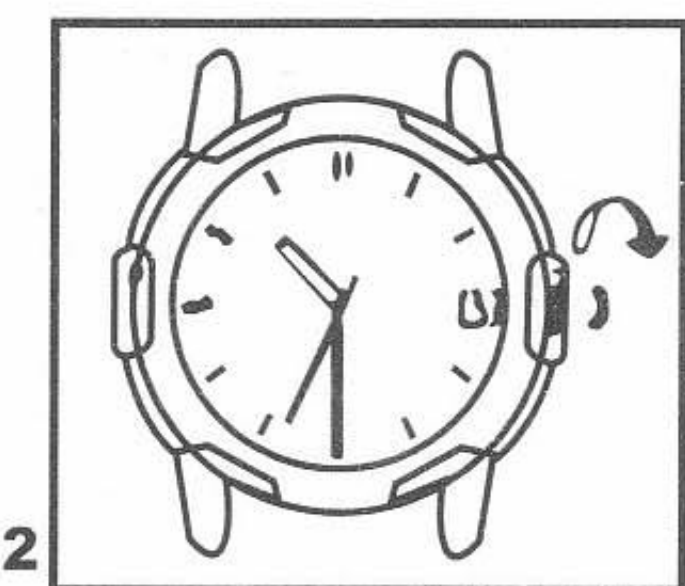
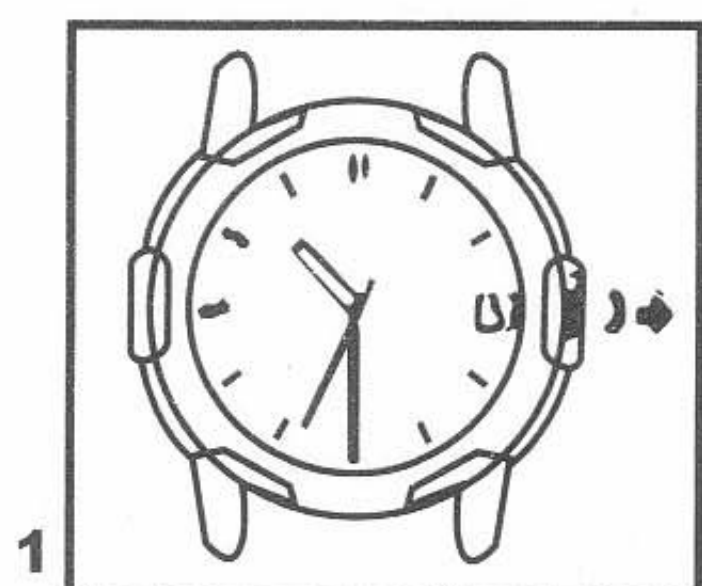
NOTE: Avoid setting date between 9:00 P.M. and 1:00 A.M.as the date might not change on the next day.

4. Push the crown back to the 2nd position. Then,pull it out to the 3rd position upon the second hand reaches 12 o'clock mark.The second hand will be frozen now.
5. Turn the crown clockwise to the desired hour and minute time.
6. Push the crown to the normal position to start.

HOW TO USE BEZEL

Rotate the mark on bezel counterclockwise to the minute hand position before diving.It can remind the diver the time that he begins diving and how long the has been diving.

REMARK:For lady ' s style,its movement is without calendar,so skip 1,2,3 steps to set time.



TO PRESERVE THE QUALITY OF YOUR WATCH:

- ★ As this watch contains precise electronic components,it is suggested that the back cover be removed only by authorized expert.
- ★ Do not operate pushers when the watch is wet or in water.
- ★ If the watch is used in water,or if it is wet, wipe it thoroughly dry.if it is exposed to sea water,rince it in fresh water and then wipe it dry.
- ★ Should water or condensation appear in the watch.immediately have,it overhauled because water can corrode electronic parts inside the case.
- ★ Although the watch is designed to withstand shocks under normal use,it is inadequate to subject it to rough impact.
- ★ Clean the watch with a soft cloth or water,never use chemical solution.
- ★ Avoid exposing the watch to strong chemicals such as gasoline,aerosol spray,paints etc.,whose chemical action will damage watch.
- ★ Avoid wearing the watch in electromagnetic condition.
- ★ Renew battery at sales store when it is used up.
